Activity #1- Snowboarding

Retrieving and combining video segments

What you are going to learn or practice

1. You will be able to, looking at the Premiere Pro screen, identify the project panel, the time line panel, the source panel and the program monitor panel
2. You will be able to start Adobe Premiere Pro project
3. You will be able to retrieve video clips to be used in your project
4. You will be able to drag video clips from the **project window** to the **time line** to make a composite video
5. You will be able to drag an audio track to the time line and trim its length.

Start a new project

6. Start Adobe Premiere
7. When the project menu appears, click on **New Project**
8. When the next menu appears, enter a name for your project and press **OK**
9. The four section premiere screen will appear.

Import Your Images

1. Go to the top **File** menu, select **Import**
2. Find the **Video Production folder**, open it
3. Find the **Premiere Pro Learning Activities**, open it
4. Find the **Activity#1** folder, open it
5. Highlight all the files in the folder and click **Open** to retrieve them.
6. The file names will then be displayed in the resource window.

Set-Up

1. **Click on the menu icon next to the project name**
2. Make sure the Project Panel is displayed in a **List format**

Procedure

1. Drag the **Snowboarding videos**, sequentially, over to the **Time Line**
2. Any space between the clips, use **Ripple Delete** to snap the videos closely together.

3. Drag the **Snowboarding music** to the audio track of the **Time Line**.
