Digital Photography Shooting Assignment

Shooting Assignment: Basic Editing and Adjustment Layers in Adobe Photoshop

Directions:

You will be required to shoot ***EIGHT*** different images of your choice using the camera in **MANUAL (M)** mode. Once you have taken ***EIGHT*** images, you will transfer them to the computer and perform basic editing on the images in relation to cropping, and resizing.

Process for Day One:

1. Set the camera Mode Dial to “**Manual (M)**”
2. Reset the camera, check auto focus
3. Set the ISO to an appropriate setting. Suggestions: Outdoor ISO should be set between 200 and 500. Indoor ISO should be set to anything above 800.
4. Take ***EIGHT*** different images of your choice. While taking pictures, make sure that you try to include lines and/or curves into the images.
5. Create a new folder labeled **Adjustment Layers Images**, in your Digital Photography Folder on your H drive.
6. Transfer the eight images to the computer.

Process for Day Two: When you have completed each of these activities ask the teacher to check and grade your work.

1. Select 1 image and **Crop** the image to eliminate unwanted background and to fill the picture with the image.
2. Select 1 image and add a **Brightness / Contrast Adjustment Layer**
3. Enhance the Brightness and Contrast of the image.
4. Select 1 image and add a **Hue / Saturation Adjustment Layer**
5. Enhance the colors of the image of the image.
6. Select 1 image and add an **Exposure Adjustment Layer** to it.
7. Correct the exposure of the image.
8. Select 1 image and Crop it and add an **Invert Adjustment Layer** to it.
9. Crop the picture and then invert the colors.
