### **Digital Photography Shooting Assignment**

Shooting Assignment: Selective Color in Adobe Photoshop

#### **Directions:**

You will be required to shoot *as many* different images as needed to satisfy the required images. Once you have taken the **required** images, you will transfer them to the computer and perform basic editing on the images, as needed, before the Black / White adjustment layer is added to each of the images.

#### **Process for Day One:**

1. Set the camera Mode Dial to “**Manual (M)**”
2. Reset the camera, check auto focus
3. Set the ISO to an appropriate setting. Suggestions: Outdoor ISO should be set between 200 and 500. Indoor ISO should be set to anything above 800.
4. Take *the images required, with the purpose of each shot in mind.*
5. Create a new folder labeled **Selective Color Images**, in your Digital Photography Folder on your H drive.
6. Transfer the eight images to the computer.

**The images that you are required to take in this shoot is:**

1. A close-up portrait of yourself with your eyes looking at the camera.
2. A picture of you holding a colorful object
3. A picture of a colorful object in the classroom, this must have plentiful background around the object.
4. A picture of a classroom or office door with wall space being shown on each side of the door.
5. A picture of someone in a crowd or group of students.
6. A picture that can be used for selective color **extra credit**
